## **Duties of Reviewers**

If an invited referee feels inadequately qualified to assess the research presented in a manuscript or foresees challenges in providing a timely review, they should promptly inform the editors and decline the review invitation. This allows the editors to seek alternative reviewers who are better suited for the task.

## **Confidentiality**

Manuscripts submitted for review, will be handled with full confidentiality; they will not be shared and discuss with anyone ... (editorial board- nominee). This confidentiality requirement also extends to invited reviewers who opt not to undertake the review.
